Jesus Christ End Times Prophecy

As interpreted from the Bible <u>New Testament Book of Matthew Chapter 24:</u>

During or around the year of 30-AD, and as it happened, one day, Jesus and His disciples had journeyed to the City of Jerusalem, and had visited the temple there and toured through all the buildings in and around the temple.

Then shall they deliver up many Christians to be persecuted, and many shall be killed: And they shall be hated by all nations for my name's sake.

And then many shall be offended, and shall betray one another, and will come to hate one another, and even desire to kill one another.

And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.



And this gospel of the kingdom shall be heard throughout the entire world, for a witness unto all nations, and then shall the end come.

When you therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place, (whosoever reads or hears these words, let them understand):

Then let those who believeth in Me, that are Christians in those days, flee to the mountains to avoid tyranny, chaos and to seek safety: Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take anything out of their house: Neither let him which is in the field or working in their jobs return back to take their clothes.



And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! But pray that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the Sabbath day:

For there shall come a great tribulation, such has not happened since the beginning of the world, nor to this time, nor shall there ever be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: But for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, He is in the desert; go not forth: behold, He is in the secret chambers, believe it not.

And then shall appear the sign of the Son of Man in Heaven: And all eyes shall see him, and then shall the population of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of Man descending from the clouds of Heaven with power and great glory.

And He shall send his Angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of Heaven to the other.



Now learn a parable of the fig tree: When its branches are yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, you know that summer is nigh: So likewise also, when you shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.

Truly I say unto you, of that generation and time, it shall not pass away until all these things are fulfilled. Heaven and Earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

But of that day and hour no man knoweth, no, not even the Angels of Heaven, but only my Father. But just as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.

For as in the days that were before the great flood, as they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.

Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be working in their jobs; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Watch therefore: For you know not what hour your Lord will come.



But know this, if the good man of the house had known at what time the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken into. Therefore be you also ready: For in such an hour as you think not, the **Son of Man Cometh**.
