U.S. Religious Landscape Statistics – June 2025

God is looking down upon the United States of America and this is what He is seeing:

About 69% of churchgoers believe that everyone will go to heaven.

About 59% of Millennials believe that pornography is morally acceptable.

Only About 30% of the American Millennial population believes that Jesus Christ was the Son of God.

About 45% of the American non-Millennial population believes that Jesus Christ was the Son of God.

Almost one-third of Evangelicals attend church out of obligation, not out of desire.

Half of all Americans have never read the Bible.

24 of 25 Millennials don't have a Biblical worldview.

About 70% of those attending church one or more times a month never share their faith with someone they are not familiar with.

One in four Evangelicals are not certain that the physical resurrection of Jesus was a real historical event.

About 51% of U.S. churchgoers say they've never heard of the term, "The Great Commission".

About 52% of Americans say the Bible was written for each person to interpret as he or she chooses.

About 70% unchurched people have never been invited to church in their whole lives.

About 65% of American churches have a weekly attendance of less than 100 people, including children.

About 46% of Evangelicals agree that God accepts the worship of all religions.

About 60% of churchgoers don't believe that sharing their faith is an essential obligation of their Christian life.

About 77% of all Americans believe that personal salvation is a result of good works.

Nearly half of young Evangelicals (ages 18-29) favor same-sex marriage.

More than 30% churchgoers say they have never felt God's Presence during a service.

About 70% of all young people who grow up in church leave the church by their 20's.

About 44% of U.S. adults say that God plays no role whatsoever in their life.

About 65% of all "Christians" believe there are multiple paths to Heaven.

One third of all Americans believe after they die, God will give them a 2nd chance.

Almost 50% of all Evangelicals, 18-29 years of age, favor same sex marriage.

Two thirds of those who are 18-34 years of age, do not believe premarital sex is ever wrong.

About 62% of all churches in America are having no growth or declines in their congregations.

About 65% of all churches in America have less than 100 people in their congregations including children.

More than 2 million people have left the church every year for the past 7 years.

In just 8 years, the percentage of the U.S. population calling themselves Christians has decreased from 78% to 70%.

About 32% of all young adults, who have grown up in church, have left the church because "it was boring".

About 50% of those in church last Sunday cannot remember a single spiritual insight from that sermon.

About 55% of those attending church at least once a month have not had a 'born again' experience.

More than 50% of those 18-24 years of age are not certain they believe in God.

More than 50% of all Evangelicals believe there is more than one way to Heaven.

About 40% of Americans believe there will be a second coming of Jesus Christ.

About 75% of regular church attenders do not believe that sharing their faith is important.

The Nones (religiously unaffiliated) are now the 2nd largest religious group in the U.S. after Evangelicals, lead by Oregon 37% and New Hampshire 35%.

One quarter of the American adult population is now religiously unaffiliated or "Nones".

At least 2.3 million people leave the church every year.

About 50% of churchgoers are unsure if people who know them are aware that they are Christians.

Only about 7% of churchgoers consistently spend time building relationships with non-Christians for the purpose of sharing Christ with them.

About 45% of Americans say they don't pray every day.

About 42% of Americans express confidence in spiritual guidance.

Sadly, the majority of the population in America is becoming detached from believing in God, and from accepting His moral commandments as a standard to guide their behavior.
