The Divine Trinity of God, Jesus Christ and The Holy Ghost

One of the most difficult concepts for many people to comprehend is what is referred to as the Divine Trinity of God.

This concept portrays God as having three identities: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Ghost, all as part of one Supreme Being. These three identities are often perceived as three distinct individual characters, separate and apart from one other.

Most people conceive that God and Jesus Christ are two different beings, God being the father figure (one individual) and Jesus being the son figure (second individual) just like that of human beings in a father and son comparison.

With God, however, it's not that way because God is spirit and is omnipresent, so God and Jesus Christ are one in the same; two beings together as one. (Revelation: 22, 12-13).

God simply manifested Himself into human form. God could not expose His celestial body to mankind so he had to transfigure Himself into human form.

That is to say that God created a spiritual human soul of Himself that would become his Son, Yeshua HaMashiach (Jesus Christ), and placed it inside a human fetus within the womb of a Virgin Female Human Being.

God then birthed Himself into the world as a mortal infant human being, eventually becomes an adult man (Jesus Christ). (Philippians: 2, 5-2, 8).

This can be very complicated for the human intellect to understand. Therefore, to make it somewhat understandable to mankind, God referred to Himself in human form as the **Son of Man**, or **the** Messiah, Jesus Christ.

The physical human body that God used, that was Jesus Christ, and was resurrected after death, was made whole, and taken up into the heavens to reside with God.

The third character of God, the Holy Ghost, is the spiritual energy of God. Everything that has life, that is alive, contains God's spiritual energy. It is invisible and without form but is still part of God, part of His omnipresence and part of His spiritual being.

In addition, it is important to understand that God the Father is also God the Mother. God is the whole and undivided parent of all life, existing in spirit as both the Father and Mother as one entity, and cares for and nurtures all life forms.

God the Father/Mother, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit, all one Supreme Being.
