In the Bible, both in the Old and New Testaments, there are approximately 100 verses that make reference to God's Judgment of mankind.

If its your desire to enter the Kingdom of Heaven after your physical death, its important that you understand what God has stated about the judgment process that each human being will be subjected to.

It is highly recommended that you read over and study these verses and view the <u>support video</u> so you can gain an understanding of what will occur when God looks into your soul, and makes an assessment of your moral character:

#### 1. Matthew 7:1-29

"Judge not, that you be not judged. For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you.

Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when there is the log in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

### 2. **James 2:13**

For judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.

### 3. **2 Corinthians 5:10**

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

#### 4. Romans 14:12-13

So then each of us will give an account of himself to God. Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

#### 5. Romans 14:10-12

Why do you pass judgment on your brother? Or you, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God; for it is written, "As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God." So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.

#### 6. **Matthew 12:36**

I tell you, on the Day of Judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak.

#### 7. **1 Corinthians 4:5**

Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before the Lord comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from God.

### 8. **Matthew 12:37**

For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

#### 9. **Revelation 20:11-15**

Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. From his presence earth and sky fled away, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened.

Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done.

And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done.

Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

#### 10. **<u>Hebrews 9:27</u>**

And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment,

#### 11. Romans 2:5-12

But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed.

He will render to each one according to his works: to those who by patience in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life; but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.

There will be tribulation and distress for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek.

#### 12. **John 12:48**

The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.

### 13. **Luke 6:37**

"Judge not, and you will not be judged; condemn not, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven;

#### 14. John 7:24

Do not judge by appearances, but judge with right judgment."

### 15. **Jude 1:6**

And the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day.

## 16. **Matthew 7:1**

"Judge not, that you be not judged.

#### 17. 2 Peter 2:4

For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to chains of gloomy darkness to be kept until the judgment.

#### 18. Acts 10:42

And he commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one appointed by God to be judge of the living and the dead.

#### 19. **1 Peter 4:5**

But they will give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

### 20. **1 Peter 1:17**

And if you call on him as Father who judges impartially according to each one's deeds, conduct yourselves with fear throughout the time of your exile,

### 21. 1 Peter 4:17

For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?

## 22. **Matthew 10:15**

Truly, I say to you, it will be more bearable on the Day of Judgment for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah than for that town.

#### 23. **2 Peter 2:9**

Then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment until the Day of Judgment,

## 24. **1 John 4:17**

By this is love perfected with us, so that we may have confidence for the Day of Judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world.

#### 25. **John 5:24**

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

#### 26. **Psalm 98:9**

Before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity.

### 27. **John 5:22**

The Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son,

#### 28. **Romans 2:1**

Therefore you have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things.

### 29. **Revelation 11:18**

The nations raged, but your wrath came, and the time for the dead to be judged, and for rewarding your servants, the prophets and saints, and those who fear your name, both small and great, and for destroying the destroyers of the earth."

## 30. **2 Timothy 4:8**

Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that Day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

#### 31. Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### 32. Deuteronomy 1:17

You shall not be partial in judgment. You shall hear the small and the great alike. You shall not be intimidated by anyone, for the judgment is God's. And the case that is too hard for you, you shall bring to me, and I will hear it.'

## 33. **Jude 1:15**

To execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him."

## 34. **John 5:30**

"I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me.

#### 35. **Matthew 7:3**

Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye?

#### 36. **Matthew 7:2**

For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you.

#### 37. **Psalm 82:3**

Give justice to the weak and the fatherless; maintain the right of the afflicted and the destitute.

### 38. **2 Peter 3:7**

But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

### 39. **Romans 14:13**

Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

#### 40. **Daniel 7:9-10**

"As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire. A stream of fire issued and came out from before him; a thousand thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him; the court sat in judgment, and the books were opened.

## 41. **James 2:1-5**

My brothers, show no partiality as you hold the faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory. For if a man wearing a gold ring and fine clothing comes into your assembly, and a poor man in shabby clothing also comes in, and if you pay attention to the one who wears the fine clothing and say:

"You sit here in a good place," while you say to the poor man, "You stand over there," or, "Sit down at my feet," have you not then made distinctions among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts? Listen, my beloved brothers, has not God chosen those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he has promised to those who love him?

#### 42. **1 Corinthians 6:2**

Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world is to be judged by you, are you incompetent to try trivial cases?

#### 43. <u>Ecclesiastes 12:14</u>

For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

#### 44. Acts 17:31

Because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead."

#### 45. **Matthew 24:36**

"But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only.

#### 46. Matthew 23:13-15

"But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut the kingdom of heaven in people's faces. For you neither enter yourselves nor allow those who would enter to go in.

Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel across sea and land to make a single proselyte, and when he becomes a proselyte, you make him twice as much a child of hell as yourselves.

### 47. **Matthew 3:12**

His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor and gather his wheat into the barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire."

#### 48. **Amos 4:12**

"Therefore thus I will do to you, O Israel; because I will do this to you, prepare to meet your God, O Israel!"

#### 49. **John 12:47-48**

If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world. The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.

#### 50. **John 3:17**

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

## 51. **Matthew 25:46**

And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

### 52. **James 2:12**

So speak and so act as those who are to be judged under the law of liberty.

### 53. **<u>Hebrews 12:11</u>**

For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.

## 54. **Romans 2:16**

On that day when, according to my gospel, God judges the secrets of men by Christ Jesus.

### 55. **Ezekiel 18:20-28**

The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not suffer for the iniquity of the father, nor the father suffer for the iniquity of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

"But if a wicked person turns away from all his sins that he has committed and keeps all my statutes and does what is just and right, he shall surely live; he shall not die. None of the transgressions that he has committed shall be remembered against him; for the righteousness that he has done he shall live.

Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares the Lord God, and not rather that he should turn from his way and live? But when a righteous person turns away from his righteousness and does injustice and does the same abominations that the wicked person does, shall he live?

None of the righteous deeds that he has done shall be remembered; for the treachery of which he is guilty and the sin he has committed, for them he shall die.

#### 56. **Ezekiel 7:3**

Now the end is upon you, and I will send my anger upon you; I will judge you according to your ways, and I will punish you for all your abominations.

#### 57. **Isaiah 3:11**

Woe to the wicked! It shall be ill with him, for what his hands have dealt out shall be done to him.

### 58. **Revelation 22:12**

"Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay everyone for what he has done.

#### 59. Romans 14:12

So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.

#### 60. Romans 2:12

For all who have sinned without the law will also perish without the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law

#### 61. **Psalm 1:1-6**

Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night.

He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers. The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

#### 62. **James 4:6**

But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

### 63. 1 Corinthians 3:11-15

For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw— each one's work will become manifest, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done.

If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward. If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

### 64. **1 Corinthians 3:8**

He who plants and he who waters are one, and each will receive his wages according to his labor.

#### 65. **John 9:41**

Jesus said to them, "If you were blind, you would have no guilt; but now that you say, 'We see,' your guilt remains.

#### 66. **Luke 16:19-31**

"There was a rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate was laid a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who desired to be fed with what fell from the rich man's table. Moreover, even the dogs came and licked his sores.

The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried, and in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side.

#### 67. Matthew 25:31-46

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats.

And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me.

#### 68. **Daniel 12:2**

And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

#### 69. **2 Peter 3:10**

But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

## 70. **1 Timothy 1:13**

Though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent. But I received mercy because I had acted ignorantly in unbelief.

#### 71. **John 3:18**

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

#### 72. **Luke 10:10-14**

But whenever you enter a town and they do not receive you, go into its streets and say, 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet we wipe off against you.

Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near.' I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town. "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida!

For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. But it will be more bearable in the judgment for Tyre and Sidon than for you.

#### 73. **Luke 6:1-49**

On a Sabbath, while he was going through the grainfields, his disciples plucked and ate some heads of grain, rubbing them in their hands. But some of the Pharisees said, "Why are you doing what is not lawful to do on the Sabbath?" And Jesus answered them saying:

"Have you not read what David did when he was hungry, he and those who were with him: how he entered the house of God and took and ate the bread of the Presence, which is not lawful for any but the priests to eat, and also gave it to those with him?" And he said to them, "The Son of Man is lord of the Sabbath."

### 74. **Matthew 12:36-37**

I tell you, on the Day of Judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

#### 75. **Matthew 11:24**

But I tell you that it will be more tolerable on the Day of Judgment for the land of Sodom than for you."

#### 76. Romans 14:10

Why do you pass judgment on your brother? Or you, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God;

## 77. **Matthew 16:27**

For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.

### 78. **Matthew 13:49**

So it will be at the close of the age. The angels will come out and separate the evil from the righteous.

## 79. **Proverbs 24:12**

The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself. "But if a wicked person turns away from all his sins that he has committed and keeps all my statutes and does what is just and right, he shall surely live; he shall not die.

None of the transgressions that he has committed shall be remembered against him; for the righteousness that he has done he shall live. Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares the Lord God, and not rather that he should turn from his way and live?

#### 90. **Psalm 23:1-6**

A Psalm of David. The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

#### 91. **Revelation 2:10**

Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.

#### 92. **Jude 1:14**

It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones,

#### 93. **James 5:12**

But above all, my brothers, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or by any other oath, but let your "yes" be yes and your "no" be no, so that you may not fall under condemnation.

#### 94. 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20

For what is our hope or joy or crown of boasting before our Lord Jesus at his coming? Is it not you? For you are our glory and joy.

#### 95. 1 Corinthians 9:27

But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.

### 96. **Luke 20:45-47**

And in the hearing of all the people he said to his disciples, "Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes, and love greetings in the marketplaces and the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at feasts, who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation."

#### 97. Mark 16:16

Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

#### 98. **Amos 3:2**

"You only have I known of all the families of the earth; therefore I will punish you for all your iniquities.

#### 99. **Proverbs 11:31**

If the righteous is repaid on earth, how much more the wicked and the sinner!

#### 100. <u>1 Chronicles 16:33</u>

Then shall the trees of the forest sing for joy before the Lord, for he comes to judge the earth.
